- Find the best way to communicate with parents
 - o Survey? May not be effective as only parents who traditionally care will respond
 - Attach survey to registration forms seems like best/easiest option
 - o Attach video with information?
 - Random phone calls to parents to get a nice sampling
 - o Text messages?
 - o Targeted headlines, Table of Contents, summary at beginning, etc.

- Brainstorming ideas for 2022-2023 plan
 - o Budget: \$105K
 - Last year, focused on reading, hired a reading tutor. Seeing improvement in reading, 75% of kids are improving in their reading courses. Also seeing improvement school-wide – improvement in kids exceeding the bar for proficiency.
 - Suggestion that we continue to fund reading as much as possible. Proficiency is down throughout.
 - John: Would like to get to every 6th grader in the next year to improve reading.
 Would love to make the reading tutor full time.
 - Will continue with reading goals
 - Currently have 3 directed reading courses available per semester
 - Can help up to 90 kids each year given class sizes
 - Should make the reading tutor full time
 - Hiring a "floater" that goes to whatever teacher needs aide that day, or needs a substitute? Could be done but must tie to a goal.
 - Warrior time is very helpful. Is the after school math tutor utilized? Not as much as we would like.
 - We could make a goal based on school culture: social/emotional things, mental health, trainings, presentations
 - Skyline does "great lunches" inviting speakers and giving kids pizza
 - Utilize the lunch time to incentivize showing up to math tutoring time. Incentivize kids to help other kids with math, science, etc.
 - Could add some teacher oversight to ensure quality of discussion
