Minutes:

- Approving January's meeting minutes:
 - o Main outcome from January: \$50K to work with for other goals
 - Motion to approve meeting minutes -- motion carries
- Tech aide updates:
 - o How much money set aside for this \$12K, should be spent this year.
 - o Can the CC do something to help?

- Trouble is there aren't applicants. There were a couple people expressing interest, but haven't filled out an application.
- Send link to CC so we can advertise.
- Request for each CC member to advertise over the next couple days.
- Original position was for this school year but there is an opportunity to continue the position into the next academic year.
- May need to revisit the need to spend this \$12K if we can't hire anyone.
- Transfer of funds to purchase Chromebooks to replace soon to be outdated G4model
 - New model of Chromebook showed up early thanks to an enterprising secretary!
 - \$37K spent on new Chromebooks.
 - \$11K was already appropriated to this purchase
 - Need \$26K from land trust to cover the new Chromebooks
 - District discourages us from carrying over funds to the next year.
 - Motion to move \$26K from land trust to cover Chromebooks, seconded motion carries
- Begin discussion for 2021-22 plan
 - For this academic year: \$19K left over which includes the \$12K for the aid.
 - Current plan for next academic year:
 - John: Literacy skills program/class class specifically for those who score lower on literacy/comprehension portions of standard exams
 - Will cost ~\$50K, leaving the land trust with ~\$50K for other efforts
 - John: would like ~\$20K budgeted to Chromebook replenishment, breakage, etc.
 - o For next academic year: ~\$30K we need to decide what to do with
 - Potential ideas/goals:
 - Question: are there smartboards in classrooms? Yes. Are they upgraded? Yes.
 - Bring your ideas to the March meeting
 - Idea from counselor/Justin tracking aid to help distancelearning students
- Next time:
 - John suggests we meet again Mar 4, discuss ideas, then prepare a document about spending plan and vote on it via email in mid-March.

0	When brainstorming ideas remember restrictions on funds: if it goes toward student learning, we can use it. Should be quantifiable, but this can be achieved relatively easily.
