

Immunization Schedule

Diphtheria/Pertussis/Tetanus

(DTP/DTaP/DT)

1 dose at 2 months
1 dose at 4 months
1 dose at 6 months
1 dose at 15 months
1 dose at 4-6 years

Measles/Mumps/Rubella

1 dose at 12 months
1 dose before entering
Kindergarten

Polio(IPV/OPV)

1 dose at 2 months
1 dose at 4 months
1 dose at 6 months
1 dose at 4-6 years

Varicella (Chicken Pox)

1 dose at 12-15 months
History of disease acceptable
Parent must sign verification
statement on school immunization
record.

Hepatitis B

1 dose at birth
1 dose at 2 months
1 dose at 6 months

Hepatitis A

This is given in a series of two doses:
1 dose at 12 months
1 dose is given at least six
months after the first dose

Recommended - Optional

Hemophilus, Influenza, Meningitis (HIB)
1 dose at 2, 4, 6 and 15 months

Exemptions

1. Medical - signed by the physician only
2. Personal - are only available for the City County Health Department
3. Religious - must be signed by a religious leader of said organization

There is no conditional admission for any students without their record in hand. There is no grace period.
