- **Safe Walking Plan Approval**
  - **The same walking plan that has been used for several years was presented to the Council and approved unanimously.**
- **Technology Safety**
  - **Dr. Higginson presented the following plan for technology safety.**
    - **Beginning of the year anti-bullying and cyber-bullying talk with principal.**
    - **“Be an Ally Assembly” on Sept. 24, 2018**
    - **“Cyberbullying” assembly for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders on October 8<sup>th</sup>.**
    - **Internet Safety Assembly on Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> for all grades**
    - **“Be Your Own Ally” on Jan. 7<sup>th</sup>**
- **Trustlands Spending thus far**
  - **Only aide salaries, planners and classroom periodicals have been spent so far.**
- **Review of School Data**
  - **The area of weakest data was math. We already set a goal for Trustlands this year to address it.**
- **Goals for the SSAP plan—first stab**
  - **It was agreed that math would be a good place to focus, but the SSAP plan called for reading and primary reading plans. We haven’t seen the plan yet, but it was agreed to try to form about the same goals.**
