1. Ms. Jensen informed the committee that she was able to locate a cart for the chromebooks saving the school \$1,500. She also stated that she would be able to order 12 more chromebooks.
2. The school will be needing 3 subs to cover teachers that would take a trip over to the Neil Armstrong Academy to observe Professional Learning Communities (PLC) meetings. The funds for the subs would be in lieu of the subs used for Data team meetings. A system support team from the district would come to West Valley Elementary to help train PLC.
3. The committee determined that it would be best to keep Trustland and SSAP goals the same. The goals that the committee felt would be appropriate for West Valley Elementary would be to focus on both literacy and Math.
 - Diebels and Granite Quarterly Benchmarks would be used to measure overall student performances.
 - Monitor the Common formative Assessments (CFA)
 - Purchasing of more equipment to improve classroom instruction.
 - Implement flex time into schedules to help struggling students achieve success.
 - Have subs to cover teachers for more assessment meetings such as PLC meetings.
