Steve Hogan visited our community counsel to discuss the 3100 South Corridor boundary study.

- The district is considering moving the Sandalwood Apartments area and Balmoral Townhomes area into the West Valley Elementary boundaries fall of 2017.
- This would bring 140 students to West Valley Elementary. Bringing occupancy back to 80%
- The Neil Armstrong Academy is at capacity.
- It is likely that the district will maintain the busing for these areas because of the Mountainview corridor. Not safe walk zone for the children in these areas.
- There will be two open house meetings to hear public input on September 28, 2016 or October 5, 2016. Locations are yet to be determined.

Granites school district projected that West Valley would have 483 students attending the 2016-2017 school year. Enrollment is currently 521 students. Almost an 8% increase. As a result the school will be able to hire another teacher.

We are very excited about the improvements we have seen 2015-2016.

- Everyone saw growth in ELA.
- 2nd & 3rd grade tried the Lexia program last year and received positive results. This year we will be using it in other grades.

- 3-6th will have 307 licenses for ST Math (Spatial-Temporal Math) - a visual math instructional software designed to help students reach math proficiency through self-paced, language-independent, mastery-based objectives.
