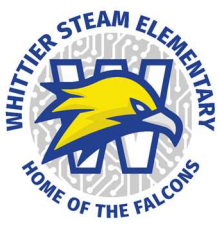

**1. Amendment to LAND Trust and Continuous Improvement Plan:**

- **Original Plan:**

- (Academic) Whittier STEAM is setting a goal to increase proficiency and growth of students in grades k-2 making typical or above typical growth in their Pathways of Progress for Reading. According to the Acadience Reading data from End of Year 2020- 2021 data of 52% to 64% for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year. For Grades 3-6, the data used to show proficiency and growth will be RISE Data. According to the RISE Data from 2020-2021 school year, we will increase from 16.5% in ELA to 26%



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proficient, increase from 19.6% in Math to 26% proficient, and increase from 25% in Science to 33% proficient. (I used Whittier prior data to help determine the increase).

- **Proposed Amendment:**

- (Academic) Whittier STEAM 2022-2023 goal to increase proficiency and growth of students in grades K-2 making typical or above typical growth in their Pathways of Progress for Literacy. According to the Acadience Reading data from End of Year 2020-2021 data of 52% to 64% for the upcoming 2022-2023 school year.

According to the RISE Data (raw) from 2021-2022 school year, grades 3-6 will increase from 27% in ELA to 30% proficient and increase from 19.6% in Math to 26% proficient.

- We had an 11% increase this year in ELA
  - For next year we changed starting at 16.5% to 27% with an increase to 30% for the 2022-2023 school year
- For math we will from from 19% this year to 26% next year (focus for 2022-2023 school year)
- Removed the science goal, however, due to the focus on math and continued support in ELA we anticipate it will increase as well.
- K-2 goal for next year is growing from 62% this year to 66% for the 2022-2023 school year
  - The increase to 62% this year is “well above typical”.
- The teachers are amazed at the ownership to do better by the kids this year and how excited they are to share their successes and making growth.
