1. District Community Council – two left. We need someone from Wilson to attend (Ana)
 - a. January 31 at Taylorsville HS, March 14 at Kearns HS
2. Panorama Data – Review schoolwide SEL Survey
 - a. Lower data on challenging feelings and student self-efficacy
 - b. Wording is kind of strange for questions. “how sure...”
 - c. Good to track – good to look at it and see how it changes.
 - d. Given 3 times – end of January and also at end of school. Check in for more data.
 - e. **Review data in February meeting for mid year.**
3. Course and enrollment priorities
 - a. Tomorrow night [board meeting](#) – final vote for boundary change. Wilson will likely get ~130 students, close to 3 teachers per grade level.
 - b. First of March get an estimate of how many students. Then, we will post for surplus and see what teachers that we get.
 - i. May have a few surplus – may have a few open positions and hiring.
 - c. Looked at new boundaries
 - d. **Monday, Dec. 19th – family night – Millcreek elementary – movie night, going to go introduce ourselves.**
4. School bullying policy and procedures and child access routing plan (safe walking)
 - a. Will be completed late in the year because we need to know about what buses are running and where.
 - b. A possibility of a crossing guard over on West Temple for new students
5. Collect data, review progress, modify as needed, including budgets and expenditures
 - a. Mid year testing! Preliminary data coming
 - b. RISE interim are happening now – similar level of rigor, good practice on online testing.
 - c. Academic goals: gain 3% on RISE (close to 50% on proficiency!) We had lots of yellows. Also, a growth of 10 points on scaled score.

- d. Early literacy – k-2 students, 70% meeting their pathway of progress goal. 60% meet benchmark. Approximately a 10% jump in reading
 - e. Budgets are continuing with funds towards afterschool (chess club, lego league, and Seussical the Musical)
 - i. 30% of Ms. Craig's salary is continuing.
