- 3. Discuss Course and enrollment priorities
 - a. Will do an open house eventually for the new parents and families that are coming to our school.
 - b. Open enrollment now for a few more weeks— can apply now and probably get in.

 - d. Send out intent forms to families in May to figure out how many are coming.
 - e. Still a lot of uncertainty, but monthly meeting with the district to plan ahead.

- 4. Discuss critical academic needs
 - a. Continued need for reading and language development.
 - b. Still TSI for English language learners and students with disability.
- 5. Procedures and the child access routing plan (safe walking), collect data
 - a. Safe walking route is due in April. We still don't have all the information about bussing and stops.
- 6. Building Leadership team stuff
 - a. Wilson BLT met a few times and discussed how to welcome in teachers and new staff.
 - b. Discussed if we may get an assistant principal? Uncertain not decided for a while.

- b. Review what funding we may lose as a result of exiting school improvement status and losing interventionists and funding.
