We will partner with parents and community members by creating an environment that respects and values diversity and gives them a voice and presence.

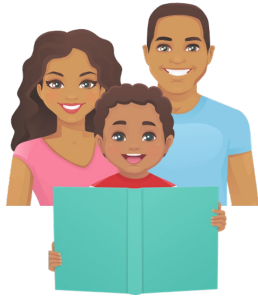
READ WITH YOUR CHILD

- Track words smoothly with 1 finger
- Read aloud together

- Don't read too fast, nor too slow
- Write down unknown words
- Have fun reading together!

Academics

WOODROW WILSON WILL:

- Provide rigorous and relevant classroom instruction based on the Utah State Core Curriculum.

- Set goals and have students track their progress on essential standards, "5 OUTs."

- Practice with or support your Scholar in reviewing grade level appropriate math activities for 10 minutes daily.
- Communicate wishes for your Scholar to their teacher.
- Review your Scholars assignments and assessments on the GSD student portal weekly.
- Ensure your Scholar attends school on time each day, at least 90% of the time.

Social Skills & Dispositions

WOODROW WILSON WILL:

- Provide bi-monthly social skills lessons with the school social worker
- Participate in Home Visits to build relationships with families
- Design and Deliver Morning Meetings to help build Scholars' sense of safety and belonging at school"

- Participate in morning meetings to help improve communication and work through problems with teacher and peers

PBIS POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTIONS & SUPPORTS

WOODROW WILSON WILL:

- Set clear expectations for behavior and create opportunities for practice
- Give out Roadrunner tickets to reinforce positive behaviors
- Provide a Roadrunner store for students to exchange tickets for prizes
- Give out Class Cash to classes to reinforce positive behaviors
- Provide Class Cash activities to reinforce positive school wide behaviors
