

Woodstock Elementary School Community Council
Meeting Minutes
December 14, 2020

Meeting Convened-3:21 PM

1. Zoom link may need to be re-sent for January's meeting. The school now has an educator Zoom account that will need to be used. Watch for a new link to be sent out with next month's meeting.
2. Budget Update:
 - a. TSSA funds (how they were spent)
 - i. .5 on a teacher. We have \$2,957.82 left over. Will likely carry over this amount over to next year.
 - ii. Para educators are on track per budgeted amount
 - iii. Playworks has been encumbered. We will likely have a \$542.06 amount to carry over to next year.
 - b. Land Trust Funds (how they were spent)
 - i. .5 on a teacher (\$0 left over)
 - ii. para educators-little leftover that we can carry over
 - iii. ST Math
 - iv. Mclass
 - v. substitutes: We will add this to next month's agenda. The school is not allowed to have substitutes, so we will need to propose and adopt an amendment reallocating funds (approx \$7100). As previously discussed we are in need of updating some technology (smartboards, chromebooks, etc)
3. Updated District Calendar: The district added additional professional development days to the calendar. January 12th will be a distance learning day, with Jan 13-15 teacher prep days to prepare for the end/start of 3rd term.

Also added March 25-26th with March 24th a distance learning day.
4. Attached to the agenda is the new video explaining the Land Trust and how it works. Council members will review on their own.
5. Parking lot: seems to be running smoothly. Ms Byrnes offered clarification re: bus lane. If buses are gone, cars are ok to pull forward & encouraged to. We talked about having a cone or sign that would let parents know once all buses are gone.

6. Covid Dashboard: The district is caught up on the cases. Now, if a school has a case, they can contact trace quicker, allowing for students to quarantine sooner and return to school quicker. The nursing staff has worked tirelessly 7 days a week to stay on top of everything.
