# **GSD/YESS Goals:**

The goal of GSD and YESS is to increase achievement for every student and engage community stakeholders. YESS is able to gather systematic data points via literacy results. We started using Star 360 last year to gather uniform data for math and reading. We are having some licensing issues with this, but will be hopefully back on track in November. PBG is being emphasized and used in our district. Modules are on Canvas for our teachers to use. District has put a lot of resources into Canvas and it is the primary online modality being used in secondary settings. Every YESS site is handling distance learning differently, but all sites are customizing student education respective to the needs of facilities and students. Common feedback from site directors is that teachers have been very flexible and adaptive. YESS is working collaboratively and effectively with its agency partners.

## **YESS Vision:**

#### **Distance Learning**

Teachers report they are using a variety of instructional delivery platforms to teach and get feedback from students. All site representatives indicated that distance learning results have been good and are pleased with the progress in increasing our scope of service delivery options unique to each site.

# **COVID Updates:**

- District has a uniform contract tracing protocol. We 100% comply with Salt Lake County Health Department guidelines. Some schools in the district have closed because of the number of COVID cases. In our school, we are guests in the facility, so we need to work together to address incidents and exposures. We have had great success working with the facilities on this. Our biggest concern is that we get timely information from facility staff to protect our staff. It is vital that we promptly have any potential cases involving school staff reported to us to meet district reporting requirements. Facility staff briefly discussed some JJS COVID protocols and the manner in which YESS will be notified. Overall, sites are taking extensive precautions with exposure identification, testing, isolating and reporting at their facilities.
