MSP Grant:

This grant will be released next month, hopefully around March 11. YESS operates on 100% grant money. We will be having some retirements with our staff. We may or may not fill these positions depending on our funding. Current sites should continue to stay in operation. We will be moving our administrative offices as well as at least one of our Transitions classrooms to Roosevelt Elementary. We will be looking to expand our units there in the long term. Summer school is funded from this grant. June 7 to July 2 is our anticipated time frame. All this depends on funding.

Technology/Google Data Form – Brenda & Trina:

We are going through accreditation this year. Our weakness last time was our lack of data. We want to use data to drive our teaching, decisions, and better support our students. We are starting with student attendance and we will go forward with more data from there. When a student enrolls, we are now collecting and recording entry/exit dates and entry/exit credits. We can now track if students are on track for graduation. Currently 87% are not on track to graduate when they enroll. We are tracking Special Ed, ELL, and 504s. Beta testing started on February 1, 2021. We are currently focusing on attendance. This will be uniform throughout our program. In the future we will track: Academic progress, behavior, court information, ETCA interaction, evaluations & results, transcripts, transition supports. CARE access would be very helpful. Lisa St Louis volunteered to help us get that access.
